Evacuation of the Sanctuary

- a) Choir on the west side will proceed to the nursery to assist with evacuating the infants through the Wellington Street exit.
- b) Choir on the east side will assist those who need assistance to evacuate the sanctuary through the doors on either side of the choir loft either the Wellington Street and /or the parking lot exits as appropriate.
- c) Ushers will ensure that the Oxford Street doors are open and assist the congregation in evacuating the sanctuary in and orderly and safe manner.
- d) Should any of the exit doors be obstructed the evacuation will proceed through the closest alternate safe exit.

Evacuation of the Church School

- a) Teachers and Hall Shepherd are to alert others in the vicinity of the emergency.
- b) Teachers or Hall Shepherd will check the washrooms on the upper floor.
- c) High School youth will exit by the staircase opposite the teen room and leave the building through the Oxford Street parking lot doors.
- **d) Students** in the upper Christian Education classrooms will exit under direction of **their teachers** down the east stairway and out the doors to the Oxford Street parking lot.
- e) If the Church School students have returned to the sanctuary they will exit through the Wellington Street doors.
- f) Should any of the exit doors be obstructed the evacuation will proceed through the closest alternate safe exit.

Gathering Place

Once you have left the building proceed to the parking lot behind the medical building across Wellington Street for New St. James.

Clearing the Building

A Leading with Care committee member will ensure that the main floor and NSJ hall is cleared.

The Hall Shepherd or designate (scripture reader) will ensure that the upper floor is cleared.

The custodian or designate (board of managers' member) will ensure that the lower level is cleared.
